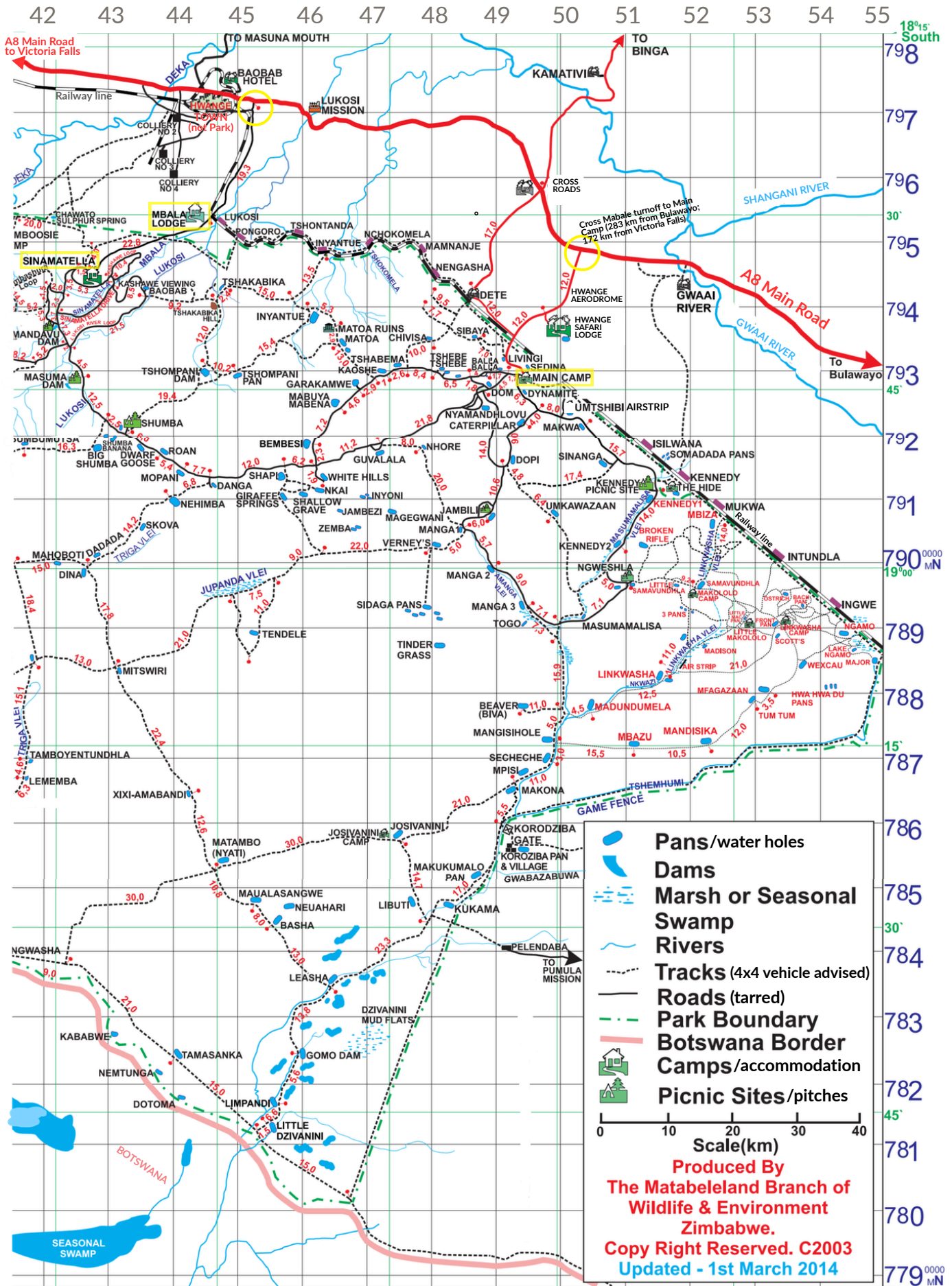


Hwange National Park, Zimbabwe: East side of the Park

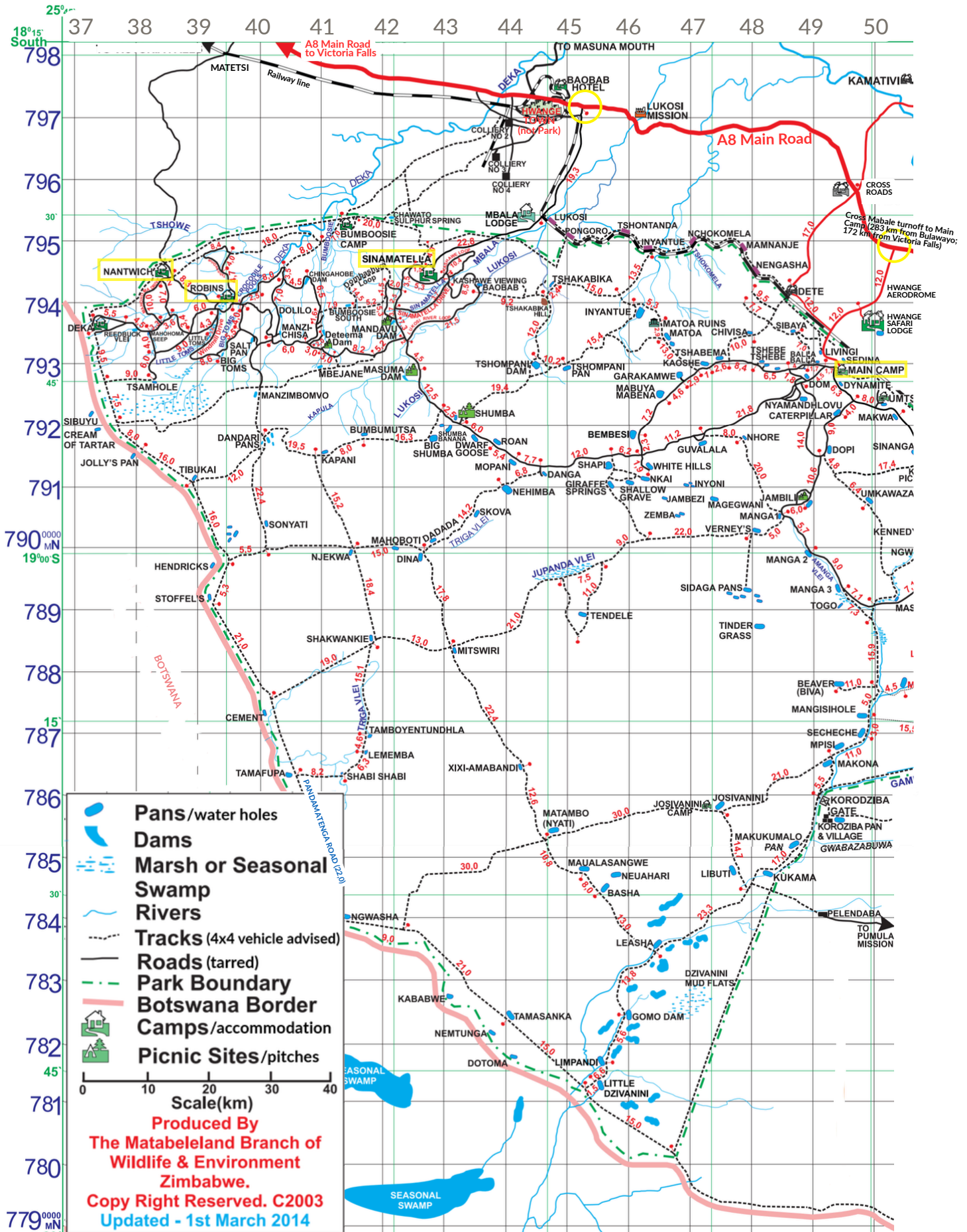
